Observational drawings are drawings from things you can observe—still life, figure, and landscape—and not drawings from a photograph or the imagination. Your drawings should look like the subjects you are drawing and not be an imaginary interpretation of your subjects. In other words, don't draw your subject as a comic book, anime, or fantasy character. Some acceptable media are shown in the examples included below.
