## Longwood University Board of Visitors to consider tuition and fees for 2021-22 academic year

The Longwood University Board of Visitors will meet in the Robins Room at Lewis Ginter Botanical Gardens in Richmond on Friday, June 11, 2021 at 2 p.m. The Board is expected to take action on tuition and mandatory fees for the 2021-22 academic year. Tuition and E&G fee increases of between 0 and 2 percent and auxiliary fee increases of between \$0 and \$8 per credit hour will be considered.

Revenue from any tuition and fee increase will support state-mandated faculty and staff compensation and benefit increases, additional support for student health services, and other unavoidable operational costs.

The Board will accept public comment at the beginning of the meeting prior to any vote on tuition and fees.
