Call to Order

The Executive Committee of the Longwood University Board of Visitors met on Thursday, November 30 at Longwood House. The meeting was called to order at 12 noon by Rector Katharine Bond.

April Cassada and Michael Walsh of the Office of the Auditor of Public Accounts provided by telephone the Board's annual "entrance" presentation to summarize the timeline and planning for the auditing process for the coming year. They gave an overview of audit objectives, plans and roles, and responsibilities, and said they aim to have the most recent audit completed by March 1, 2024.
