Longwood University Board of Visitors to consider tuition and fees for 2022-23 academic year

The Longwood University Board of Visitors will meet at the Baliles Center at Hull Springs Farm in Montross on Monday, June 6, 2022 at 10 a.m. The Board is expected to take action on tuition and mandatory fees for the 2022-23 academic year. Tuition and E&G fee increases of between 0 and 5 percent and auxiliary fee increases of between \$0 and \$9 per credit hour will be considered.

Revenue from any tuition and fee increase will support state-mandated faculty and staff compensation and benefit increases that are currently under consideration by the General Assembly, as well as inflationary cost increases for materials and services.

The Board will accept public comment at the beginning of the meeting prior to any vote on tuition and fees.
